Responsibilities for activities aide

- Observe resident attendance, mood, behavior, and degree of involvement so that facility activities and resident progress are evaluated, by noting, reporting, and charting resident behavior
- Assist in the creation, planning, developing, organizing, implementing and evaluating of the activity programs
- Plans and implements group and individual activities to improve or maintain the participants' cognitive, physical, social, psychosocial, and artistic needs
- Assist in developing a written plan of care for each participant's activities program that identifies the strengths/needs of the participants and the goals to be accomplished for each opportunity identified
- Maintain equipment, supplies and a neat and organized work area
- Assist with aquatic recreation, sensory activities, and lead field trips by driving the center's van
- Spend time getting to know the residents, participate in activities, brainstorm with the team to come up with new events and activities
- Interview residents or others to assess and evaluate appropriate activities that will assist with physical, social, emotional and cognitive functions
- Work directly with resident in developing an individualized treatment plan with goals based on assessment and consistent with state and federal guidelines
- Develops and leads a variety of therapeutic recreational groups and programs including but not limited to discussions, life reviews, reminiscing, current events, exercises, socials, music, educational events, crafts, games,

Qualifications for activities aide

- Familiarity with volunteer programs
- Familiarity with care plans and MDS
- Licensed or registered in Florida as a therapeutic recreation specialist or as an activities professional by a recognized accrediting body OR is eligible for licensure as a therapeutic recreation specialist or as an activities professional
- Possesses two (2) years' experience in a social or recreational program within the last 5 years, one (1) of which was full-time in a therapeutic activities program
- Fluent ability to understand oral and written english directives
- The ability to perform all physical requirement pertaining to delegated tasks as defined on RU-91 form
