Responsibilities for aircraft inspector

- To ensure that all materials subject to shelf life are properly controlled, inspected on a regular basis and removed from service when the shelf life expires
- The Lead Inspector will be properly certificated in accordance with FAR Part 65
- In his absence, all duties of the Lead Inspector may be delegated by him to any qualified personnel as necessary
- Records test equipment calibration information and test data during system tests
- Ensures technicians are aware of RII requirements for task being performed
- Performs shelf life inspections of materials used and verifies equipment and tooling serviceability during the repair process
- Provides technical assistance for the proper application of technical data
- Complies with repair station procedures and company policies and procedures
- Ensures that all inspections are properly performed on all completed work in accordance with internal procedures, customer and FAA requirements
- Ensures his/her training requirements are current according to company and customer requirements

Qualifications for aircraft inspector

- Assignments require Advanced Knowledge of all possible tasks and

Regulations and Functional Work Standards that affect Technical Requirements and Outputs

- As required by the position, must have the ability to wear a respirator as per OSHA 29 CFR 1910.134 "Respirator Protection" regulations with no restrictions that would prevent the proper use and/or seal of the respirator
- Thorough knowledge of aircraft mechanical component troubleshooting/repair procedures and replacement of components
- 5 years recent rotary wing maintenance / modification on H-60, H-47 and / or H-6 aircraft
- The Quality Assurance (QA) Inspector shall have a minimum of five (5) years within the last ten (10) years experience performing repair and modification of high performance aircraft
