Responsibilities for all-source analyst

- Research and analyze military, political, economic, technical and other developments within assigned areas to conduct valid threat
- Engage components within the customer organization to address targeting requirements and develop new leads for exploitation
- Conduct detailed searches on items of interest and relay pertinent data to relevant customer components
- The successful candidate will have knowledge and experience of the various intelligence disciplines and the Intel Community
- Perform records management functions by maintaining large volumes of intelligence reports pertaining to threats from small unmanned aerial systems, and develop assessments based on overall databased findings
- Maintain current operational and strategic situational awareness of events in combat zones
- Work directly with customers and team members to research, evaluate, analyze, fuse, and interpret reporting from multiple sources to produce current and finished intelligence products, primarily related to improvised explosives and threats
- Contractor personnel shall have and maintain the ability to conduct all-source analysis of the customer Areas of Interest (AOI) (as defined by the customer Plan)
- All-Source contract personnel shall have and maintain the ability to gather and analyze information, and provide recommendations necessary for the Government to produce, disseminate, and apply intelligence products in the
