Responsibilities for ambulance driver

- Driver must be familiar with city and county roads
- Driver will learn the safe operation of wheelchair lift, wheelchair tie downs and all other Van equipment
- Any need for repair is immediately reported to the supervisor or fleet maintenance personnel
- Understands and follows safety procedures specifically related to job duties
- Assist, move and handle patients, who may be ambulatory or wheelchair bound, using appropriate equipment where necessary carrying patients up the stairs using carry chair, moving immobile patients in and out of bed, and manoeuvring patients in wheelchairs into and out of the vehicle and on stretchers as necessary
- To be flexible on a daily basis to support all PTS hospitals/locations where applicable
- Be aware of the vulnerability of some patients and ensure safeguarding concerns are reported and escalated should there be concerns about an individuals safety
- Operate interchangeably as either driver or attendant in a single person or 2-person ambulance crew and act and promote teamwork to ensure high standards of service delivery
