Responsibilities for anesthetist

- Responds to situations requiring Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation, and initiate appropriate resuscitative measures
- Performs an individualized pre-anesthetic assessment and evaluation of the patient to include review of consultations, history and physical, and relevant diagnostic studies
- Under the direction of an anesthesiologist, develops an anesthetic plan based on the patient's physiological response and implements plan in the presence of an anesthesiologist
- Applies appropriate noninvasive and invasive monitoring modalities for continuous evaluation of the patient's physical status throughout the perioperative experience
- Administers and continuously monitors the effects of anesthetic medications, fluids and ventilator support
- Facilitates emergence and recovery from anesthesia and provides handoff communication to receiving unit postoperatively (PACU, NICU, PICU)
- Assesses acute and chronic pain modalities individualized to patients in the operative area, pain clinic and on in-patient wards
- Provides post-anesthesia evaluation and discharges patients from the postanesthesia care area when appropriate
- Complies with all aspects of patient safety, infection control and quality care
- Performs duties of a SRNA as defined in the School of Nurse Anesthesia Student Handbook

- Must be able to demonstrate good organizational skills and effective written and verbal communication skills in working with a diverse population of physicians, patients, patient's families, and medical staff
- Prior work as an anesthetist in an acute care setting is preferred
- Prior work history with cardiac anesthesia is beneficial
