Responsibilities for animal programs

- Effectively communicate with Animal Science Faculty, Extension personnel (on a State, Regional and County level), Tennessee Department of Agriculture, small ruminant producers and other stakeholders
- Develop youth educational programs, including curriculum and contest content, in cooperation with the State 4-H office and other youth organizations related to small ruminant production
- Provide state-wide support and leadership through in-service training, farm visits, phone calls/emails, publications, for Extension personnel in the area of small ruminant production systems, which may include frequent day and overnight travel
- Work collaboratively with Animal Science and other UTIA faculty to produce peer-reviewed publications and grant applications
