Responsibilities for applications developer lead

- Good working knowledge of Automation Tools (QTP, Selenium etc)
- Support UAT Testing and analyse any defects identified
- Ideally have experience working with test harnesses and synthetic data generators
- Use Java/J2EE, Hybris eCommerce Development and Hybris PIM
