Responsibilities for associate programmer analyst

- Informs the design and development of systems, user interfaces, data models, and data integrations
- Serves as the System Owner for selected applications, maintain the production change control schedule and participate in change control processes
- Creates and maintain technical documentation such as SOPs, design documents, operational drawings, manuals
- Collaborates with Service leads to deliver the assigned projects/programs
- Supports daily monitoring of applications, file transfers and job execution to insure application and system availability is high
- Supports various internally developed and vendor developed systems
- Provides routine and emergency production support (some off hour support required as need arises)performs analysis, assesses risks and offers solutions for resolution
- Supports monitoring and remediation of security scan vulnerabilities
- Troubleshoots application and client related issues by performing analysis,
 risk assessment and implements resolution
- Supports team technology projects and systems upgrades
