Responsibilities for automation technician

- Prepare and conduct Statistical Analysis (CPK, DOE and Gage R&R)

- Ensure Cleaning and Work in 6S tasks(organize, clean area)
- Participate in LEAN and Continuous Improvement events
- Perform all PTS Automated production related activities
- Perform equipment set up and maintain equipment for automation manufacturing
- Maintain accurate batch record paperwork and departmental records
- Responsible for cleaning and preparation of clean rooms, stocking fill supplies, performing pre-fill potency test and preparing reusable supplies for autoclaving/depyrogenation
