Responsibilities for automotive painter

- Otherwise prepare items for application of paint, lacquer or other protective or decorative
- Remove damaged sections of vehicles using metal-cutting guns, air grinders and wrenches, and install replacement parts using wrenches or welding equipment
- Cut and tape plastic separating film to outside repair areas in order to avoid damaging surrounding surfaces during repair procedure, and remove tape and wash surfaces after repairs are complete
- Prime and paint repaired surfaces, using paint spray guns and motorized sanders
- Ability to sit, stand, kneel or lay in various positions around military equipment with the intent of surface prepping, sanding, masking, taping, covering over, priming, painting, inspecting and retouching painted areas to completion of the painting task IAW applicable MILSPEC standards
- Must have ability to use various air powered, electric and non-power tools in sitting, standing, and kneeling positions around military equipment
- Properly use, store, account for, and disposal of hazardous materials and waste used and generated in the performance of duties
- Movement of materiel and assets with forklifts and dollies
- Must be able to pass pulmonary function test
- Must meet all medical requirements for the PPE required to operate in the painting facility

Qualifications for automotive painter

- Knowledge should include a basic understanding of and familiarity with Military and DoD standards

- 3+ years of experience in applying high end automotive finishes
- Experienced with applying water and solvent borne paint systems
