Responsibilities for automotive painter

- Monitor painting operations to identify flaws and correct their causes
- Finishing processes such as buffing and waxing
- Operate lifting or moving devices to access materials needed or areas to be painted
- Cross-train and assist in other divisions as needed
- Tack off surface to be painted
- Prime and or paint the interior, white roof or black rubrails and warning lights
- Self-inspect to minimize defects
- This is a hands on training position
- Notify Cell Leader when issues arise
- Understanding defects and how to identify them

Qualifications for automotive painter

- PFT and Respirator Fit test may be required
- Must know theory and principles of vehicle paint application
- Must have or be able to obtain site forklift and other licenses/certifications as needed to perform duties
- Must be able to paint a diverse range of vehicles
- Must be able to complete paperwork associated with vehicle repairs
- Must be able to manipulate and use hand tools and hydraulic equipment
