Responsibilities for business analyst SAP

- Quickly understand business needs and translate that understanding into a form that leads to the creation and/or composition of better process, organizational and/or technology solutions in line with best practices and standards
- Learn the ins and outs of the existing solutions and identify potential improvement opportunities for system integrations
- Responsible for the configuration and ownership of Love's implementation for their functional area (FICO, PS and BPC)
- Elicit and effectively communicate internal and external customer requirements for system and process changes
- Analyze and document as-is process and complete supporting documentation, including process diagrams
- Establish process performance measurements to be able to constantly monitor, control and report end-to-end process performance
