Responsibilities for business architecture

- Eliciting and analyzing data to identify trends and areas of opportunity to help support recommendations for increasing efficiency
- Development and documentation of front-to-back current and future state business process flows
- Working with Operations to agree the future state operating model and training staff on any new functionality and changes
- Provision of regular status updates to core team and senior stakeholders
- Serving as an ambassador for the initiative
- The Business Analyst (BA) drives the Business Analysis process, including soliciting and documenting requirements, identifying problems that need solutions, and opportunities for systems and workflow enhancements in a future state
- The BA plays a Subject Matter Expert role in solution delivery, including UAT, training and preparing the business for the system solution
- The BA assists the Service Strategy Manager in facilitating overall Service Strategy planning and execution, including roadmap curation and small project management
- The BA serves as the conduit between the user community and the solutions teams through which requirements flow, and is involved at some level throughout the entire Systems Development Lifecycle
- Analyze and document business processes, scenarios and information flows

- Improve the discovery and planning process by identifying cross-business synergies to enhance efficiencies and better serve business needs within the Managed Product Platforms
- Demonstrable consistency and progression in prior work experiences
