## Responsibilities for business continuity management

- Support Corporate Security and BC leads during actual incidents
- Be a BCM point of contact in EMEA, supporting the EMEA BCM Lead
- Using LDRPS and working with the business functions in the region, maintain the business continuity plans in line with the corporate BCM standards
- Provide guidance and support to business functions in the development of recovery plans
- Reporting of metrics to support program standard requirements
- Review and challenge any instances of undue risk-taking by business and functional executives in the identification of risks, the definition of risk tolerances, the selection of continuity tasks and strategies or the testing of continuity plan
- Partner with regional / business line executive to create, coordinate and maintain a multi-discipline Incident and Crisis management team to provide a resilient response for regional / business emergencies
- Act as a secretary to the business line(s) / regional incident management teams and maintain a working relationship/liaison with other incident management teams
- Serving as the key Relationship Manager and Risk Advisor to business and infrastructure units for Business Continuity Management (BCM) functions
- Ensuring business adherence to Global BCM Policy and Standards, including Business Continuity Planning and the development of recovery solutions, Business Testing, Call Tree and Emergency Communications, Awareness

## Qualifications for business continuity management

- Development and execution of business continuity and resiliency exercises within lines of business
- Identify and liaise with Business Continuity Coordinators (within business lines) to develop effective working relationships and plans
- Maintain and update the Business Continuity/Crisis Management internal corporate website and develop awareness materials
- Perform risk analyses for individual business areas to identify points of vulnerability, single points of failure and identify risk avoidance and mitigation strategies
- Develop status reports (score cards) on departmental continuity plans and prepare management summary reports
- Analyse and report on implications of regulatory/audit/underwriter requirements and industry guidance on business continuity programs
