Responsibilities for business systems analyst lead

- Engage with the business users at different levels to understand business needs, document the requirements
- Translate business requirements to system functional design
- Gathers & documents business and functional requirements from business stakeholders
- Self-starter attitude, working independently under limited guidance
- Provide insight on all Enterprise Architecture domains (business, information, application and technology) and how they connect
- Advise business of enabling technology that can improve business processes
- Leads/performs the formulation, definition, and documentation of systems/application scope and objectives working closely with systems architecture, development and engineering teams
- Determines and ensures resolution to highly complex system/application problems
- Acts as the primary liaison between key business area and systems teams,
 and communicates project feasibility, status and issues to key stakeholders
- Provides project task level supervision to Developers, Business System Analysts, and / or Sr
