Responsibilities for cardiac sonographer

- Performs routine echocardiograms under the supervision of a Registered Cardiac Sonographer
- Expected to independently perform complete transthoracic studies, following United written protocols for adult echo
- Must demonstrate knowledge of proper TEE probe disinfecting techniques, using Cidex OPA and the Medivator
- Maintain and clean equipment used in both invasive and non-invasive echo procedures, following established health and safety guidelines
- Perform data entry specific to each procedure (patient demographics, billing, report maintenance)
- Rotates as needed to cover outreach clinics and weekend call
- Recognizes equipment malfunctions and takes appropriate corrective action
- Perform exercise stress and Dobutamine stress echoes
- Perform appropriate contrast examinations as needed
- Dispense and charge for all equipment and services utilized in providing patient care

Qualifications for cardiac sonographer

- Registered Cardiovascular Sonographer (RCS) or Registered Diagnostic Cardiac Sonographer (RDCS) required within two years of hire date
- Registered through Cardiovascular Credentialing International or American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers required within two years of

- One (1) year of clinical or two (2) years as a registered technologist preferred
- Knowledge of how to use defibrillator and crash cart
- Ability to gain optimal cooperation from adult patients
