Responsibilities for cardiac

- Initiates and sets-up equipment for each stated procedure
- Is able to multi task and function as a table operator and circulate for needed equipment during the procedure
- Maintains radiation safety at all times using the safe distance rule
- Maintains a balance of supplies for utilization during procedures while being cost conscious
- Is a customer service representative and meets or exceeds all of tenets customer service skills
- Performs a variety of technical procedures, utilizing specialized angiographic equipment for the diagnosis and identification of cardiovascular and peripheral vascular disease entities, , the therapeutic intervention to treat the disease process
- Travel to out of town clinics on regular basis and/or to provide coverage as needed
