Responsibilities for cardiovascular technician

- Consistently utilizes collimation, and optimal source image distance in minimizing exposure to patient and surrounding personnel
- Consistently programs proper pressure injection rates, assuring pressure injector syringe is appropriately purged and air free
- Consistently Demonstrates effective radiation safety for self and all other personnel utilizing, time, distance and shielding
- Consistently performs patient observation during procedures
- Identifies, initiates, and follows through on opportunities for improvement related to quality care
- Initiates the SALT process, participates in Safe Choices investigations and Root Cause Analysis (RCA) as events are identified
- Demonstrates the ability to perform in the role of surgical scrub by anticipating the needs of the surgeon and keeping the circulating nurse informed of any needs throughout a procedure
- Minimizing radiation to patient and staff by practicing radiation protection techniques, using beam restrictive devices, and patient shielding
- The Cardiovascular Technician (CVT) is an individual who, after comprehensive training, is qualified to perform Cardiac Stress Tests, Tilt Table Testing, and Electrocardiograms (EKGs), related clerical duties associated with performed procedures
- Stocks supplies and assemble, disinfect, and store equipment

Qualifications for cardiovascular technician

- Ability to perform accurate, tedious studies along with sound judgment, planning and decision making abilities
- Current CST preferred
- Graduated from Surgical Technology training program or LPN program required
- Prefer graduate of approved program for Cardiology Technician
- EKG recognition course required within 6 months of employment
