- Performs monitoring and analysis of cardiac rhythms as part of complex care team
- Ensures prompt submission of high-quality images add documentation sent to PACS (image quality, correct marking, annotation and patient data / history)
- Ensures equipment functions properly

Qualifications for cath lab

- Graduate from an accredited school of cardiovascular technology, or equivalently accredited allied health program, or
- A Bachelor of Science degree, or
- Associate of Science degree, or an accredited allied health degree

- Current BLS and ACLS certifications, required by completion of the unitspecific orientation and before working independently
- Registration as Surgical Assistant or Surgical Technologist with the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies pursuant to C.R.S
