Responsibilities for certified registered nurse anesthetist

- Completes pre-anesthesia assessment of the preoperative (pre-procedure) patient
- Administers all types of anesthetics and places necessary invasive monitoring lines with supervision by an attending anesthesiologist
- Post-anesthesia management of patient
- Providing appropriate invasive and non-invasive monitoring modalities utilizing current standards and techniques
- Evaluating patient response during emergence from anesthesia and instituting pharmacological or supportive treatment to insure patient stability during transfer
- Accepting additional responsibilities which are within the expertise of the individual CRNA and are appropriate and relevant to the practice setting as determined by the Chief of Anesthesia, Chief CRNA, or the Clinical Director Attending Anesthesiologist
- Administer and maintain regional anesthesia
- Responsible, under the supervision of a staff anesthesiologist, for provision of high quality anesthetic care of medically complex patients undergoing a full range of non-obstetric adult surgery in one of the VA's highest-complexity surgical facilities
- Responsible for the pre-anesthetic patient evaluation, preparation
- Manages care for post-operative patients in the Post Anesthesia Care Unit, Portland Outpatient Procedures & Surgery and associated clinics, Critical Care Unit and wards in conjunction with surgeons and nurses

- Federal DEA license (within 90 days of proctoring period)
 - Current BLS, PALS, ACLS certification
 - Must be a graduate of an accredited school of nursing and an accredited school of nurse anesthesiology
 - Must have a master's of science degree in anesthesia
 - Must possess both a Michigan registered nurse license and a Michigan certified registered nurse anesthetist license and have current recertification through AANA
 - Must be ACLS certified
