Responsibilities for certified registered nurse anesthetist

- Select, recommend, order or administer appropriate preoperative anesthetic medications
- Provide anesthesia care which is consistent with current infection control practices
- Recognizes abnormal patient responses during anesthesia implementing corrective action as necessary
- Provide anesthesia care that is consistent with patient safety policies and procedures
- Records all pertinent events taking place during the induction of, maintenance of and emergence from anesthesia, including the dosage and duration of all anesthetic agents, other medications, intravenous fluids and blood or blood components on all patients that have received anesthesia care on approved anesthesia record
- Postoperative Management
- Ensure patient's postoperative condition has met all criteria for discharge and appropriate information has been provided to patient
- Provides follow-up evaluation and care related to anesthesia complications and/or side effects
- Select, recommend, order or administer appropriate post-anesthetic medications
- Performs an assessment immediately prior to induction of anesthesia of the patient and documents this in the medical record
