Responsibilities for certified surgical technologist

- Provide training/precepting to new clinical staff regarding clinic policies and procedures
- Utilizes safe practices
- Prioritizes care
- Ability to communicate well with patients, Teammates, physicians, other members of the healthcare team
- Assumes responsibility for maintaining aseptic technique during surgical procedures, taking steps to correct breaks in technique as appropriate
- Scrubs on all types of operative procedures, providing assistance by passing instruments and sutures and generally anticipating the surgeon's needs and assisting him/her as necessary
- Is flexible in regard to scheduling and cooperates with legitimate requests
- Participates in call rotation as required
- Work collaboratively with surgeons, anesthesiologists, RN circulators, scrub techs, and other surgical personnel in delivering high quality, safe patient care in a cost effective manner
- Be responsible for training and orientation of new staff, resource management, supply management, and maintenance of Preference Cards

Qualifications for certified surgical technologist

- Job requires standing for prolonged periods
- Completion of an operating room/surgical technologist course and comprehensive orientation is required, (graduation from an accredited surgical technologist program is preferred)
- Previous Surgical Tech experience in an hospital is a requirement
- Graduation from a Certified Surgical Technician/Technologist program plus a minimum of one year intra-operative experience
