Responsibilities for city planner

- Generate shop orders for both production and assembly
- Analyzes product demand patterns and trends to develop demand forecasts in conjunction with Sales/Marketing input
- Develops purchase forecasts for 3rd party and Intercompany suppliers
- Analyzes inventory then develops and implements reduction plans to achieve Net Working Capital targets
- On a monthly basis, provides quarter/year ending inventory projections to Finance for Corporate reporting
