Responsibilities for class B truck driver

- Performs driving duties associated with industrial tank cleaning, utility work, facility shutdowns, emergency response, site remediation, rail car cleaning
- You will make route service calls to new and existing fleet and automotive clients across your assigned territory
- You will be provided regulatory and job training
- Operates a Class B Box Truck on an established route, selling company products and services to new and existing clients within in the industrial and automotive sectors
- Up-sells existing customers on the company's products and services and develops new business through the generation of new leads from businesses that could benefit from recycling used oil (or another waste stream) and other environmental compliance programs
- Adhere to weight limits and ensure proper utilization of equipment
- Ensure compliance with Department of Transportation (DOT), Hazardous Materials/Waste (HAZMAT) and RCRA requirements/regulations
- Maintain up to date DOT, OSHA, and all company-required training
- Drive a Class B Tanker or Box truck delivering new oil products in bulk and packaged format
- Loading and offloading own trucks at customer facilities

Qualifications for class B truck driver

- Basic knowledge of truck components in order to complete pre- and post-trip inspections
- Requires knowledge of Texas State Department of Transportation rules of the road
- Must be able to operate a class B vehicle
