Responsibilities for clinical data management

- Manage build and develop a highly effective team data management team aligned with the needs of the portfolio
- Support the Data Acquisition Specialist(s) in their key responsibilities
- Responsible for hiring, training, development and management of staff
- Identifies need for external support
- Promote understanding of the Mission and Core Values as it relates to quality improvement, patient safety and our patient experience
- Provide technical project support for PAMC in meeting quality improvement goals and objectives which improve patient care across the care continuum, particularly where the ambulatory and hospital spheres overlap and patient care may be compromised
- Identify and track quality metrics likely to be tied to national or regional performance measures of the hospital, the likely links to “pay for performance”, and work to support projects for improvement
- Provide leadership for the continued development, growth, and refinement of the Clinical Data Warehouse (CDW)
- Work collaboratively with leaders in an effort to ensure that key metrics are identified, defined, and tracked to better realize improvements in areas of providing safe, effective, compassionate, quality care
