



Example of Clinical Instructor Job Description

Responsibilities for clinical instructor

- Complete the weekly clinical evaluations mid-term and final clinical evaluation for each student
- Limited trips to campus as directed by the Dean's office or Department Head
- Other duties may be assigned by the Department Head or Dean
- The Department frequently needs to utilize non-tenure track, part-time instructors to teach online courses in its Master's and Doctoral programs
- Provide office hour availability for students enrolled in UBC 399 (both in person and virtual)
- Revise and update instructional materials and methods of assessment
- Consult on issues related to the scheduling of UBC 399 sections
- Responsible for training and day-to-day supervision of Capstone TAs and adjunct instructors
- Responsible for administrative tasks associated with the Capstone as they arise
- Teach Clinical Nutrition and/or Food Service Management courses in Master of Clinical Nutrition Coordinated Program

Qualifications for clinical instructor

- Knowledge of Neurology and Stroke
- Masters level education in Nursing, or Health Care Related Field
- At least 2 semesters collegiate instructional experience required

- Course development, including online instruction experience, preferred
- Candidates must be board certified by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology
