Responsibilities for clinical nurse educator

- Develop, coordinate, implement and evaluate educational programs and services to meet the learning needs of Obstetrical Registered Nurses and Nursing support staff
- Be responsible for both hospital and unit based education program planning, development and implementation
- Teach courses that are required for competency
- Maintain competence at the expert level in clinical practice
- Assess education needs of staff upon hire or transfer into the unit and on an annual basis
- In collaboration with staff members, develop individualized education plans for staff
- Be a clinical expert - able to independently manage high acuity, complex patients typically cared for on the unit
