## Responsibilities for clinical nurse leader

- Provide formal and informal education, mentor staff and serve as the clinical point of contact for interdisciplinary team members
- Utilize evidenced-based practice to achieve improved patient outcomes in the microsystem of an acute care unit
- Maintain bedside nursing skills by assisting in complex procedures, admissions/discharges/transfers, and/or staffing when needed based on patient care needs
- Leadership & Management. Assume responsibility for overseeing nursing and non-nursing personnel on a unit

- General Management.Perform daily leader rounding and assure team members are regularly rounding on all patients
