Responsibilities for clinical pharmacy specialist

- Actively participates in the development, implementation and maintenance of guidelines, policies and standards
- Actively participates in professional development activities
- Actively participates in clinical research
- Be responsible for providing collaborative drug therapy management (CDTM) services in clinic, telephonically, by e-visits, and possibly telehealth
- Educate team members to continually advance the service level of practice
- Provide drug therapy management and consultative services which will include a review of participant's drug profiles, working with prescribers to optimize drug regimen, monitoring quality of pharmacy practice, and providing inservice education to Interdisciplinary Teams
- Monitor patients for appropriateness of anticoagulation
- Document pertinent findings and patient face to face encounters in the electronic medical record
- Develop, document, and execute plan of care utilizing national guidelines or established local protocol
- Provide ongoing anticoagulation care for chronic problems as delineated in protocol

- Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy, Doctor of Pharmacy, or other advanced pharmacy degree
- Post Graduate Year One (PGY1) & Post Graduate Year Two (PGY2) Pharmacy Residency in specialty area consistent with practice needs of institution or
- Graduate from a school of pharmacy with a Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) degree
- Completion of an ASHP-accredited pharmacy residency is preferred
