Responsibilities for clinical pharmacy specialist

- Refer patient to ED or alternate service if warranted in discussion with physician
- Be in a clinical position that assists in all aspects of processing prescription refill requests
- Function in accordance with all state and federal rules, regulations, statutes and Board of Pharmacy Administrative Rules
- Use established guidelines and/or protocols
- Facilitate authorization of medication refills for clinic patients
- Collaborate with physicians, clinical pharmacy specialists, technicians, clinical pharmacy department programs and services to optimize medication therapy
