Responsibilities for clinical specialist

- Develops, collects, analyzes, and maintains data, files, reports, and other information concerning critical care issues, deficiencies, and improvement opportunities, either manually or within a database management system
- Provide clinical/technical support during sales process by demonstrating full range of product features including potential uses, product capabilities and benefits to customers as needed
- Provide troubleshooting on issues that arise related to end-user's technical/clinical skills, experiment design and results of clinical results on daily practice
- Participate in product development teams by becoming involved in product/marketing testing
- Providing clinical customer support to orthodontists and general dentists in the areas of case evaluation, ClinCheck support clinical troubleshooting primarily for Italian doctors
- Working cross-functionally with Product Development, Regulatory Affairs, Product Management, Launch Team and Marketing on pipeline and lifecycle projects
- Reviewing input for the Clinical Evaluation Report (technical file documents, marketing claims, post-market surveillance data)
- Identifying and screening business and product relevant scientific literature
- Analyzing and interpreting study results and compiling literature search reports for regulatory submissions
- Works with the Division Clinical Specialist Team to identify and promote

Qualifications for clinical specialist

- Bachelors Degree (or higher) in Nursing (BSN)
- Requires a valid RN
- Minimum of 5 years or experience in a clinical setting as a nurse or pharmacist
- Experience in a health plan, PBM, Medicare or State Medicaid with focus on reimbursement and/or claims processing preferred
