- Tracks pathways and performs various other business office functions on an as needed basis
- Obtains insurance authorization and pre-certification specifically for chemotherapy, radiation, urological, surgical, and PET/CT services
- Directs the clinical review work load of staff including auditing work for accuracy and completeness, re-assigning work, and establishing priorities
- Provides procedure guidance and direction to staff
- Reviews reports for claim denials and works with staff on status and problem resolution
