Responsibilities for commodity leader

- Understand business compliance requirements and drive opportunities to eliminate compliance and commercial risk
- 20% Administrative and data quality initiatives such as inputting data into sourcing systems
- Incorporate use of key levers into the regional strategy (preferred supplier penetration, e-Auctions, e-Catalogue usage/content, Days-to-Pay, TPS penetration,) to maximize savings and cash impact including tracking of targets & reporting progress
- Participate in simplification projects
- Identify and assess supplier capabilities
- Accountable for the commercial management of all transfers, customer enabled material changes and new products in Procurement
- Accountable for gaining supplier quotes and interrogating supplier price and lead times
- Support the commodity Manager in developing and implementing the commodity strategy
- Relationships and reduces cost and risk within the supply chain
- Attend the weekly/monthly supplier MFT reviews as required

Qualifications for commodity leader

- Physically healthy and flexible to accept around 30% travel

- Minimum of 5 years' experience in purchasing or related fields in a manufacturing environment
- Daily communication with internal (Procurement Operations, IPT's, Commodity & Commercial) and external customers (predominately Airbus regarding enabled materials)
- Accountable for ensuring on time response to all enabled material requests from the customer and that the customer systems are updated accordingly
- Work with Procurement Operations and the Planning & Logistics teams to ensure SAP Master Data contains enablement information
