Responsibilities for community health

- Develop and maintain relationships with local community partners and agencies, key regional and national individuals and organizations
 - Develops program content based on research and analysis of subject and population-specific data and community needs
 - Develops and implements marketing campaigns to promote awareness of programs and resources
 - Serves as a community health resource and consultant to staff, physicians, community agencies, and other community health professionals
 - May collaborate on procuring funding and resources that support program initiatives
 - The Community Health Supervisor is responsible for oversight of Community Health programs
 - Principal duties include hiring, training, supervising, expense control, and data collection related to program evaluation
 - He/She is also responsible for coordination of outreach, scheduling events, department statistics, data collection and supplies
 - The Community Health Supervisor works as part of a team in the San Fernando Valley, across the Region, to implement programs that address the health needs identified by the Community Health Needs Assessment
 - Attend weekly case review meetings where they will discuss challenging cases, CHW best practices, and undergo continual training and professional development
