Responsibilities for construction field engineer

- Reviewing drawings for constructability and providing interpretation to craft and/or installation subcontractors

- Performing quantity takeoffs and assist with the preparation of field material requisitions
- Conducting site visits for the purpose of producing daily reports of the work and/or subcontractor activities
- Coordinating input to the quantity tracking and progress database used for measuring project completion
- Monitoring actual cost versus budget
- Preparing punch lists
- Attending subcontractor bid walks and assist in bid evaluation to support subcontract award
- Maintaining the highest level of safety awareness and ensure all tasks are completed to the highest safety standards
- Assist in developing work processes

Qualifications for construction field engineer

- Requires a working knowledge of engineering- and construction-related processes, some familiarity with industry practices
