## Responsibilities for construction safety manager

- Performs a debrief presentation to the field staff in a classroom environment
- Performs follow up calls and conference call with divisional/Regional/National leadership to finalize site assessment reports
- Follows up division visits with clear and concise communications summarizing research findings
- Conducts training sessions with the divisional field teams
- Maintain COR certification within Ontario and Alberta
- Review and maintain OBE Safety Program within the Canada and the United States
- Prepare cost summary and budget records

- Bachelor's degree in safety, ergonomics, engineering or a related field required
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- Bending, stooping, reaching, lifting and balancing
