Responsibilities for corporate finance manager

- Manages the preparation and distribution of period-end internal financial reports and analysis
- Prepares ad hoc analyses and participates in special projects, as needed
- Develops and maintains a risk-based system of internal controls, including related documentation, to ensure the integrity of financial information and compliance with external reporting requirements and Company policies and procedures
- Proactively identifies and initiates continuous improvement initiatives across the Department, to ensure top-quartile performance
- Stays abreast of business partner strategy / goals and actual results to proactively seek ways to provide accounting and finance insights and support to assist them in achieving their goals
- Serves as coach and mentor for the team to support professional development, employee engagement, retention, and succession planning
- Provide financial planning and analysis support to Finance VP Corporate
 Functions during the annual Budget planning process and forecast updates
