Responsibilities for crew chief

- Inspect Missile/PGM assets in accordance with USAF surveillance inspection program IAW 11A-1-10 and applicable technical orders
- Update Combat Ammunition System (CAS) as is applicable to the Missile Element processes and authorized access rights
- Inspect, operate and perform maintenance on light vehicles and handling equipment such as, forklifts, pallet jacks, and manual hoists
- Inspect and operate metal strapping equipment, stencil machines, heat sealers, pneumatic paint guns, air/power tools
- Inspect and perform minor maintenance on facilities and installed equipment
- Interface and coordinates between Crew Members and Section Supervisors
