Responsibilities for CT scan technologist

- Interact with the patient and family members to support a positive experience
- Adhere to the PRN guidelines
- Perform various types of CT scans according to protocol
- Up to 1 Year of Position-Related Experience-preferred
- Reviews each examination for technical accuracy making sure all of necessary anatomy is included on the study
- Dispenses appropriate preparations to patients as indicated by departmental protocol and/or physician order
- Administers contrast according to department protocols and utilizes power injector for IV contrast administration
- Performs POC creatinine testing on outpatients as needed
- Performs IV starts using the appropriate gauge angiocath on patients requiring IV contrast administration
