Responsibilities for CT technologist

- Properly communicate/troubleshoot equipment problem/failure/schedule service/adjust patient schedule when needed
- Protective radiation protection
- Review all studies prior to submission
- Communicate with ordering physician and/or radiologist when needed
- Participate in cross training of staff
- Perform a variety of C.T
- Explain procedures to patients, monitoring for patient safety and comfort, administering contrast (IV and/or Oral)
- Conduct imaging in accordance to established protocols and quality standards
- Perform associated duties, , transporting patients when necessary and assembling all associated paperwork and images to provide the radiologists for dictation, cleaning and stocking rooms
- Transfers patients to CT table, assists patients with positioning, and applies immobilization devices as necessary

Qualifications for CT technologist

- This position is full-time days weekends plus 1 weekday
- RT(R)(CT)(ARRT) or registry eligible required
- Certificate from an approved/accredited Radiologic Technology program or

- Graduate of an AMA-approved Radiological Technology, Nuclear Medicine or Radiation Therapy School
- Certification//degree in Radiologic Technology, Nuclear Medicine, Computerized Tomography, or Radiation Therapy
