## Responsibilities for diagnostic medical sonographer

- O Patient injuries or complaints
- O Equipment malfunctions
- O Procedure time-out
- O Missing or inappropriate exam requisitions
- Prepares for exams prior to patient's arrival
- Facilitates the performance of interventional procedures such as reading the providers order, gathering medical history, coordinating care with other departments, setting up correct equipment and supplies, using proper sterile technique and communicating appropriately with performing physician
- The clinical educator(s) is responsible for clinical coordination, instruction, and evaluation with didactic education as assigned by the program director
- Evaluates and ensures the effectiveness of the clinical affiliate/clinical education centers
- Assists with scheduling sites for clinical experience and assures clinical site preceptors possess and maintain adequate experience and credentials
- Performs clinical site visits, maintains clinical visit log, clinical contracts and annual agreements including establishing new sites
