Responsibilities for dialysis

- Assists with the supervision and training of Dialysis Technologists
- Responsible for the team's development, progress and improvement
- Provides close working support to the technical team
- Maintains and monitors all technical Q/A and Q/C audits, technical documentation and reporting, adequate inventory of supplies and equipment parts
- Cleans and disinfects of equipment, reusable jugs, and systems
- Participates in clinical research projects as needed
- The Dialysis Registered Nurse provides professional nursing care to patients of the Hospital and under the license of the Hospital in need of renal replacement therapy
- Documents patient's physical assessment, vital signs, patients treatment reviews and observations in patient medical records
- Analyzes patient assessments, dialysis orders, laboratory results and, discusses issues with the nephrologist
- Provides initiation and discontinuation of the prescribed renal replacement therapy, including but not limited to formulating a plan per physician orders, verifying safety measures are in place and complied with, administering medications or other appropriate treatments, and documenting all activity appropriately on the hemodialysis flow sheet or hospital EMR
