Responsibilities for dietetic technician

- Views patient medical record for pertinent needed nutrition-related information and determines proper diet from diet prescriptions, which cover aspects of diet such as calorie/protein levels and carbohydrate distribution
- Provide instructions to patients on appropriate diet under the direction and guidance of the Registered Dietitian
- Perform quality assurance of Patient Tray Service (PTS) to ensure optimal patient care
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- Conducts nutrition assessments, care plans, education, and provide appropriate follow up
- Supports the Food Service Director (FSD) in implementation of therapeutic diet needs, including daily orders, tray assembly, sanitation, training of staff, proper documentation as it relates to therapeutic diets
- Conducts periodic test trays
- Promote student success by showing flexibility in style and work schedule exhibiting a passion for teaching students and engaging students in the learning process
- Supports basic nutrition services of population served to ensure nutrition needs and customer satisfaction levels are met
- Collaborates and communicates with culinary and clinical departments on
