Responsibilities for dietitian

- Partner with nurses and primary physicians to provide nutrition recommendations and education for patients and families
- Assess the nutritional status and provides nutrition intervention to residents and their families/caregivers, including diet education
- Screen residents for nutritional risk and malnutrition
- Develop and present dietary plans of care as part of the dietary and nursing team
- Provide nutrition consults/assessments as requested by other team members
- Coordinate nutritional care with caregivers in multiple community settings, including transitional health care workers, assisted living health care workers, nursing home health care workers and dialysis centers as needed
- Maintain nutrition summary for all residents
- Use clinical nutrition standards of care to assess patient nutritional needs
- Teach patients, families, and care providers principles of the nutrition plan
- Counsel and support patients and clients as needed, taking into account individual patients' special physical or age-related needs
