Responsibilities for director medical

- Support strategic alignment of the assigned clinical program working cross functionally and partnering with other key functions as outlined
- Serve on cross-functional study execution teams (SET) for assigned trials, working with other team members to achieve efficient, high-quality study execution and to function as medical lead and medical monitor for global phase 3b/4 clinical trials
- Responsible for medical interpretation of data (clinical trials, registries, published literature,) for in-development and/or marketed compounds
- Align Global Medical Affairs objectives with those of Clinical Development and Commercial operations to ensure programs meet the needs of all stakeholders
- Hold overall accountability for the management of the medical department, which includes medical science liaisons management, pharmacovigilance and clinical trials within the Affiliate
- Keeps product and development project information up to date based on internal and external publications
- Keeps close interaction and communicates with Global and Country medical affairs functions
- Play key role in supervising the planning and implementation of all project activities, ensuring that all activities are properly and timely performed and that outputs are accomplished and delivered according to the agreed work plans
