Responsibilities for discharge planner

- Rounds with Social Services and other hospital staff to develop discharge plans and discuss possible discharge problems
- Coordinate care planning with the internal primary care treatment team, including peer support, community agencies
- Under the direction of the Case Manger Director perform Discharge Planning functions for the Case Management Department
- Responsible for arranging referrals for post discharge needs of patient and or family choice
- Communicates with physicians, nurses, therapies, case managers and third party payer regarding the discharge plan
- Under the direction of a RN Case Manger performs utilization review functions for the Case Management Department
- Demonstrates participation in professional growth and development,
 maintaining required knowledge and skills needed to perform the duties of the position
- Be responsible for identifying the discharge needs of the patient and family, and facilitating a smooth and safe transition from the hospital under the general supervision of the Director, Case Management
- Identify patient/discharge needs to assure that both receive support with resources and placement assistance
- Oversee, with the assistance of a Case Manager, the appropriateness of stay in the hospital, both acute and skilled

- Basic knowledge of the care management process
- Possess the ability to respond to high volume, fast paced clinical and office setting
- Maintain a professional, neat work environment, manages stress in order to maintain a professional demeanor and perform multiple tasks simultaneously
- Facilitate the transition home by ordering equipment, arranging and referring home health visits, contacting the Home Health Services prior to discharge, and initiating a follow-up telephone call after discharge
- A minimum of two (2) years direct clinical experience in a psychiatric or mental health setting
- Experience in working with programs and outside referrals preferred
