## Responsibilities for distribution center manager

- Reports on customer budgeted sales and forecast activity
- Maintain daily contact with centralized Customer Service (in establishing customer priorities and communicating potential customer outages), inventory control (for stock-outs, new product launches, ) and 3rd party transportation providers (to meet delivery schedules and manage carrier capacity effectively)
- Responsible for preparing and submitting the expense and capital expenditure budgets for the distribution centre
- Advises the Marketplace IT Manager of local issues and opportunities as they arise
- Analyzes operating and delivery procedures, systems and schedules and all other distribution centre activities to identify potential efficiency improvements and cost-savings
- Serve as project or facility leader for green field distribution center set-up and go-live including management of contractors and sourcing of capital equipment and staff to support go-live
- Serve as project or facility leader during Warehouse Management System design and implementation for system upgrade or new system conversion
- Direct and oversee the work of the Bartlett Distribution Center team to meet all production goals of the various division product lines in the timeliest manner
