Responsibilities for distribution supervisor

- Coordinate all damage and charity stock transfers
- Makes safety a priority
- Training and coaching of procedures for associates
- Responsible for all training requirements including initial, follow-up and special training, cross-training team members to ensure coverage in all areas, administering equipment control process, including for all lift trucks, RF guns, printers, pick-to-voice headsets
- Supervise, motivate, direct and evaluate a team of Distribution Personnel

- Serve as an Alternate Facility Security Coordinator as part of the TSA Certified Cargo Screening Facility Program
