Responsibilities for drilling supervisor

- Assist Drilling Supervisors with issues on the drill site
- Maintain COP owned drill pipe and yard
- Ensure locations being constructed and conductors set for upcoming locations
- Tertiary qualification in Mine Engineering
- Certificate IV trainer/assessor and exposure to training of others
- WA Restricted Quarry Manager's ticket
- To prepare data and information collected and correctly transfer the prepared information
- To provide information to the Senior Drilling Completion Rig Supervisor immediately should there be any significant problem, incident or change to program, drill string washout/twist off, unexplained pump pressure increase/decrease, major increase in gas levels, positive flow check/ "kick" or other well control situation, drilling fluid loss circulation, major tight hole/stuck pipe, any accidents/injuries etc
- To supervise drilling and completion operations carried out by Company's and Contractor's personnel at rig site
- To supervise drilling and completion activities in accordance with drilling programme, specification, Company procedures and best practices

Qualifications for drilling supervisor

- Responsible for making appropriate recommendations that will prevent or

- Responsible for making appropriate recommendations that will minimize the impact of wellbore conditions
- Responsible for making appropriate recommendations that will minimize the impact of contaminants
- Responsible for making appropriate recommendations related to the drilling fluids system that will improve hole cleaning efficiency
- Additional intermediate or advanced knowledge and skill requirements will apply for complex drilling operations such as those encountered in deepwater
- Able to explain the impact of hole conditions
