## Responsibilities for ECHO technologist

- Perform echo tests/stress echo tests
- Print echo schedules
- Answer patient questions regarding testing
- Create phone notes in electronic medical record system and send to providers
- Gather pertinent documentation for ICAEL reaccreditation
- The individual will work to adhere to ICAEL standards for the facility and will take advantage of continuing education
- Determines appropriate methodology and techniques to use
- Prepares facilities in accordance with procedural requirements
- Monitors the patient's physical condition during the course of the procedure
- Troubleshoot equipment and document errors or equipment malfunctions

## Qualifications for ECHO technologist

- Associate's degree in Cardiovascular Technology or graduate of an accredited school of
- 1 year experience in hospital environment (Preferred)
- Graduate of a diploma, associate, or baccalaureate academic program in health science (including, but not limited to, cardiovascular technology, ultrasound, radiologic technology, respiratory therapy, or nursing) or graduate of a programmatically accredited program in cardiac ultrasound (echocardiography) strongly preferred

- Currently registered American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonographers as a Registered Diagnostic Cardiac Sonographer (RDCS) or via CCI as a Registered Cardiac Sonographer (RCS)
- This position is full-time rotating weekends and does require a flexible schedule
